RESPONDING TO AN INCIDENT... think response

RESPONSE

- Review scene and ensure no dangers**
- Evaluate first aid requirements**
- Secure scene**
- Preserve and protect, gather evidence**
- Only report factual information**
- Notify GCC and duty manager of area**
- Submit report**
To relevant business manager or PRIME for all GAL staff before leaving site
- Ensure corrective actions**
(reduce re-occurrence)

Fire and evacuation information

ON DISCOVERY OF A FIRE

REPORT



Break glass at the nearest fire alarm point. Call Fire Service by dialling **222** on an internal line or **01293 501222 / 999** on a public line. State 'Fire' and give precise location.

ACT



Try to put out the fire **ONLY** if it is safe to do so, using the appropriate fire fighting equipment.

DO NOT PUT YOURSELF AT RISK!

EVACUATE



Use the nearest available Emergency Exit route to the appropriate Assembly Point or Refuge Area (see plans overleaf) or move to an area where the alarm is intermittent or silent.

Continuous alarm = Evacuate
Intermittent alarm = Be prepared to evacuate

EVACUATION

- Help the public to evacuate in an orderly manner.
- Less mobile persons must be assisted to the nearest safe area such as an emergency exit stairwell or refuge area. Listen carefully for public address announcements.
- Do not use the lifts.
- Report immediately any persons unaccounted for and the location of less mobile persons to the Fire officer or Assembly Point Marshall at the Assembly area.
- Wait until the 'all clear' is given before returning

REMEMBER

Act on the alarm bells

Do not telephone the Gatwick Control Centre for confirmation

Security Information

TELEPHONED BOMB THREAT

- Remain calm and listen carefully
- Write down all that is said
- Attract the attention of other staff to help
- Try to discover:
 - **Where is the bomb right now?**
 - **When is it going to explode?**
 - **What does it look like?**
 - **What kind of bomb is it?**
 - **What will cause it to explode?**
 - **Did you place the bomb?**
 - **Why?**
 - **Any other useful information?**
- **DON'T HANG UP!**
- Note the exact time of the call
- Inform your supervisor
- The supervisor to notify the police by dialling **222** on an internal line or **01293 501222 / 999** on a public line
- Complete a Bomb Warning Report

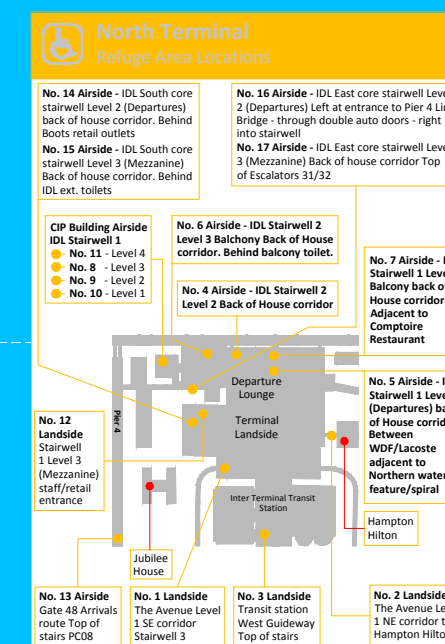
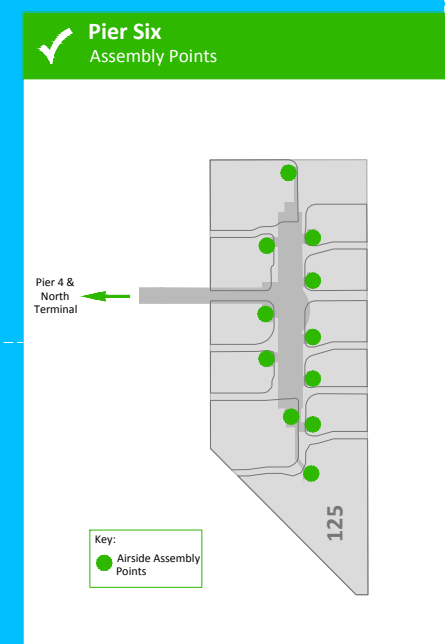
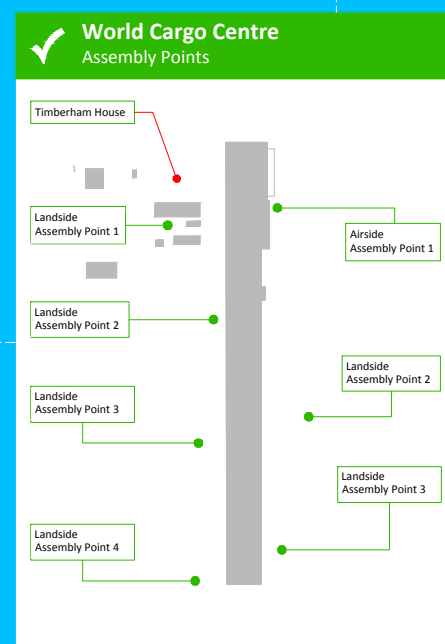
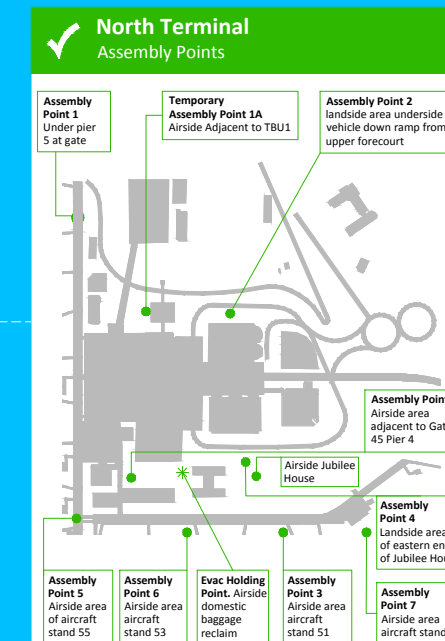
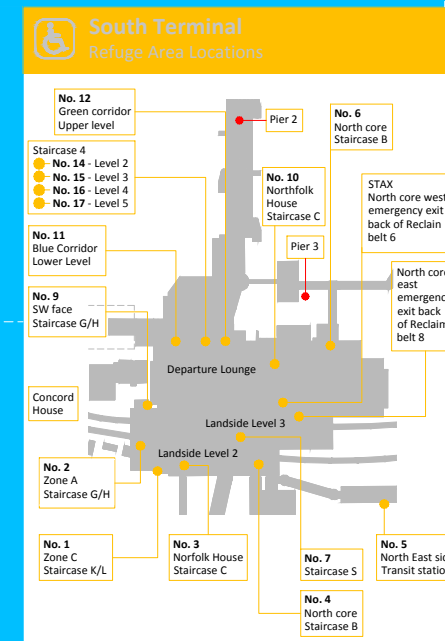
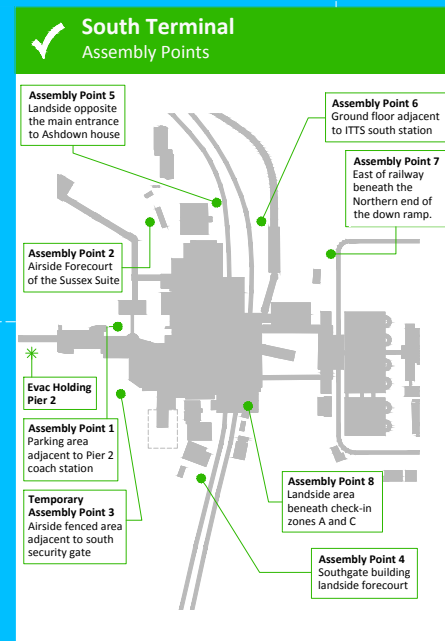
UNATTENDED ITEMS

- Do not touch or move suspicious items
- Remain vigilant at all times
- Beware of suspicious people, incidents and packages
- Report them to the Police, by dialling **1212** on an internal line immediately or **01293 501212 / 999** on a public line
- Co-operate fully with any instructions that may be given by the Police or GAL staff

REMEMBER

Always be alert

Never look after baggage belonging to other people

WASTE

- Minimise the production of waste
- Separate recyclable waste (eg. plastic bottles, metal, wood, cardboard, paper)
- Separate hazardous waste (eg. aerosols, paints, oils)
- Separate electrical and electronic waste

- Report all fly tipped waste

SPILLS

- Report ALL spills

ENERGY

- **SWITCH** off equipment when it is not needed and safe to do so

- If you are unsure if equipment can be switched off, ask your line manager

WATER

- Report leaks or dripping taps

Destination Zero

Our aim is to make Gatwick a safe place for our passengers and everyone who works at the airport

We believe that every incident can be prevented if we all work together to eliminate unsafe acts or conditions

Examples of unsafe conditions include, slippery floors, trailing cables, poor housekeeping,

unprotected building site, leaking oil containers

Examples of unsafe acts include, standing on top step of a ladder, employee not wearing PPE, speeding, pouring oils/chemicals down the drain

DON'T WALK BY

It doesn't matter where you work at the airport you

can help. If you see something which could lead to an Environment, H&S or Fire incident, please respond by:

- Where it is safe to do so, speak to someone who may be working unsafely and highlight the risk
- Reporting any concern to you line manager
- **SEE IT, REPORT IT**
